Below are the check-in and start times for all five sports, the volunteer roles you may have been assigned, parking information for scent work competitors, and the order of classes for each sport.

This does NOT include competitor running orders within the events, but does include the number of competitors for each event / class. Running orders will be available in the official catalogue.

Please note that you must attend the check-ins and briefings for each sport that you are entered in.

At check in, please let the sporting trial manager (Jeanette) know if you are expecting to also be in the show ring and we will work out the best approach.

Please note that this is our breed specialty national, so some things may occur differently than at a local trial. We ask for patience and flexibility among competitors especially if there are clashes with conformation. Event start times may also be delayed if the sport before it has not finished. We will not be running more than one sport at a time.

Scent Work Trial Order of Classes

Check in: 7:15am, Briefing: 7:30am, Judging: 8am.

Judging will pause between 8.30 and 9am for the official opening

Parking instructions for <u>ALL SCENT WORK</u> competitors: Check in for Scent work will be in the parking area indicated on the map below. From 7.15am until the Scent work trial has finished, ALL competitors must stay within the boundaries indicated in red on the map to avoid seeing search areas, or you risk disqualification. The permitted areas include the off-lead yards, the canteen, and the main toilets, as well as plenty of open grassy area to toilet dogs.

If you would like to set up a gazebo at the show rings, this must be done before 7.15am or after the scent work trial is finished.

If you are competing in the show ring during this time, don't stress, just please let the trial official (Jeanette) know at check-in.

Briefing at 7:30am will be for ALL search areas.

- 4. Novice Containers and Novice Interior (5 dogs). These two classes will be run back-to-back, meaning the competitors will each do their container search and then move with the judge, straight to their interior search
- 5. Advanced Exterior (6 dogs)
- 6. Excellent Exterior (4 dogs)
- 7. Advanced Vehicles (8 dogs)
- 8. Excellent Containers (3 dogs)
- 9. Novice Exterior (5 dogs)
- 10. Advanced Containers (8 dogs)
- 11. Excellent Vehicles (3 dogs)
