Important information for our SprintDog™ Trials

The Welsh Corgi Club of NSW does not tolerate harassment, bullying, or discrimination of any kind. We respectfully ask all competitors to engage with kindness, courtesy, and respect to each other and competing dogs at all times.

- By entering, exhibitors consent to photography and use of images for Club promotion.
- Dogs must have their Showmanager profile linked to the Dogs Australia database ie. be a Registry Dog.
- Competitors need to arrange their own Handlers. You must nominate your Releaser and Catcher when applying to compete and both must be financial members of DOGS NSW (or equivalent state body) and be over 16 years of age.
- Both Releaser & Catcher require a lead i.e. two leads per dog.
- Exhibitors bring their dogs' height card. Dogs without a card will be measured at check-in. Please fill in a height card before presenting your dog for measurement. Blank height cards will be available on the day.
- All dogs that are eligible may attempt Run 1. Only dogs that successfully complete Run 1 without being excused or disqualified will be eligible to attempt Run 2.
- Dogs must be kept under effective control at all times and on-lead unless competing. Dogs displaying aggression or unsafe behaviour may be removed from the event.
- Please warm up your dog away from the Sprint Zone and exclusion areas.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete or allowed on the grounds. Bitches must be a minimum of 10 weeks post whelp to compete. Mated bitches or bitches in whelp may not compete.
- The trial will be conducted in accordance with Dogs NSW Extreme Weather Policies. The Club reserves the right to delay, modify or cancel the event in the interests of dog welfare. The Club reserves the right to make any changes to ensure the smooth conduct of the event, to cap entry numbers and to accept or reject entries.
- Participation is at the exhibitor's own risk. The Club accepts no liability for injury, loss or damage to dogs, persons or property.
- The Judge's decision is final. Officials may excuse or disqualify any dog or handler for safety or rule breaches.
