Catching Pen system will be in use. All entries MUST have a catcher and/or releaser, entrants to organise this. Please ensure that both handlers have a lead.

PRESENTATION: At the completion of the trial and after all equipment has been packed up.
Qualifying/Pass cards/sashes and Title Sashes will be available after Run 2 at presentations.

Conditions of Entry:

Entries will be capped at: 140

- . Judges and officials can compete.
- . The Committee reserves the right to substitute/add Judges or Lure operators should the need arise.
- . The Club has the right to close entries early if entries reach the cap.
- . **40 places will be kept for GSP entries, if this is not filled it will be opened to other competitors**
- . If temperature is forecast for 32 degrees the night before event on the BOM website, then event will commence half an hour earlier with a designated break in PM. Refer to rules for heat policy.
- . Consider the fitness of your dog. Ensure all dogs are warmed up before each run
- . Dogs can run with a flat collar (no hanging tags) or naked.
- . Dogs unsuccessful in their first run, cannot have a second run until after the conclusion of qualifying dog runs (if time permits)
