Conditions of Entry:

All competitors, essential helpers, event officials and volunteers must carefully read.

All must abide by the following measures at all times whilst on the grounds, failure to comply with the following COVID -19 Rules will result in removal from the competition and grounds.

If you have not been well or have a temperature of 37.5 or above PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND

Please be familiar with the COVID Education – Exhibitors, Competitors and Members and COVID Education - Physical Examination of a Dog sections of the Dogs Victoria COVID-19 Update Hub at <https://dogsvictoria.org.au/members>.

PLEASE RESPECT THE COVID MARSHAL AT YOUR RING.

If there are any issues, they should be dealt with via the COVID MARSHAL for your ring – they will make contact with the Show Manager / Show Secretary if necessary. Please note if the issue cannot be dealt with you will be asked to leave the show. DV Regulations and the COVID Regulations contained herein are the instructions you are to follow, if circumstances change you will be informed by the COVID Marshalls or Club executive only.

Gates will open at 7am, you will be checked in by the Gate Officials, please print off your attendee slip to show at the gate, if you do not have your attendee slip you will be required to either complete a contact tracing form or check in via QR code. Please enter via Dogs Gate and exit via Main Gate

There will a coffee van present however there will be no food vendors, a list of local cafes will be in the catalogue

HYGIENE AND HANDWASHING:

- Hand sanitiser will be available throughout the venue and bathrooms.
- Bathrooms will be cleaned often throughout the day. Other common surfaces will be sanitized at regular intervals.
- The sharing of equipment is NOT permitted
- Exhibit numbers and catalogue will be emailed.
- There will be no place ribbons available at this event
- The Exhibitor must not touch or place equipment on the ring tables/ramps, if this does occur the exhibitor must sanitize the ramp/table

PHYSICAL DISTANCING:

- Physical distancing of 1.5m must be maintained at all times
- Gazebo set up as per latest DV Regulation contained within email that was sent out on 26th March
- Distance at least 1.5m apart, follow the advice of a Covid Marshal in setting up a gazebo and check it is at least 1.5m from adjacent gazebos. Marshalls have a 1.5m measure stick for that purpose.
- You can share a gazebo with others including persons who are not from your household. If you put up the sides you must not exceed 1 person per 2m² (3m x 3m = 4 people).
- While waiting for classes ring side exhibitors and helpers must adhere to social distancing.
- Exhibitors will enter the ring via the entry gate and leave via the exit, any change over of dogs will take place in a coordinated safe matter without rushing
- Exhibitors will mouth their own dogs
- Masks are not mandatory for the exhibitor and judge during the close physical assessment of each exhibit
- A face mask must be carried at all times and worn if physical distancing is not possible
